Ref: Clause 380 [WHS Regulation 2011 \(NSW\)](#) and Table 10.2 in Schedule 10 and HS335: Prohibited and Restricted Carcinogens Procedure

The following substances are prohibited unless they are being used for genuine research purposes and prior authorisation has been obtained from WorkCover. This applies to pure substances and where the substance is present in a mixture at a concentration greater than 0.1%.
